

PRESS RELEASE

The Island County Board of Commissioners is seeking applicants to fill a vacated position on the Water Resources Advisory Committee (WRAC) representing District 2 – Oak Harbor. Applicants must reside within the area they are representing. The position will run through June 17, 2015.

The WRAC monitors water resources in Island County and recommends to the Board of County Commissioners management and improvements of existing plans and programs, coordinating efforts with other water resource management activities in the county. The WRAC consists of twelve voting citizen members, four from each of the County Commissioner Districts representing various water resource interests: groundwater, stormwater, non-point planning, watershed management and salmon recovery.

All WRAC meetings are held on the first Thursday of each month from 3:00pm to 5:00pm. Meetings are typically held at the City of Oak Harbor Public Works Facility (1400 NE 16th Avenue, Oak Harbor) or the Camano Island Senior Center (606 Arrowhead Road, Camano Island).
